MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON AUGUST 2, 2022.

Meeting called to order at 9:01 A.M. by Chairman Rusty Eddy with members Tom Heidenwirth and Greg Barnett present. Moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motioned by Heidenwirth, second by Barnett to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried.

Tim Junker, Allison, inquired about the pipeline and if any new information was available. Barnett commented that Heartland pipeline has proposed updates to the route with more public meetings taking place. Richard Blau, Shell Rock, was present to check on the railroad line inconvenience for residents near the Logistics Park. As the railroad crosses his driveway, he is sometimes unable to access the gravel road. He has missed appointments due to this. He also indicated that others have had taxes decreased because of the inconvenience, and he was wondering why his were not lowered. Eddy directed him to the Assessor's office to get an answer to this question.

Eddy motioned to open a Public Hearing on a FY23 Budget Amendment, second by Barnett. All ayes. Motion carried. Auditor Leslie Groen provided details on amendment items as follows: Revenue: \$1.4 million was received as the second tranche of ARPA funds has been received. The County has now received its total ARPA funds in the amount of \$2,804,606A. A HAVA grant of \$10,000 was received by the Auditor's office which will be used for election security. Expenses: Public Health increased their mileage budget by \$8,500 due to the County's mileage increase. Elections budget increased by \$10,000 to utilize the HAVA Grant, and ARPA expenses increased by \$1,450,000 to fund the Public Health building addition. With no public comment heard, motioned to close public hearing by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth. All ayes, motion carried.

Following discussion, it was motioned by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to adopt said amendment as follows:

Kelly Peuse, the daughter of Joel and Rosemary Sult, was present to discuss the railroad crossing lighting in rural areas. Peuse provided a statement regarding the tragic death of her parents and introduced her family, who joined her in attendance. In her statement she indicated that she personally went to the crash site and saw that there is a main railroad line that runs east/west with a spur line running parallel just to the south of the main railroad line. At this intersection, the main line has cross buck signs with lights and audio alert. The spur line has crossbuck signs only, no lights and no audio alert. Neither line has crossing arms. Although the spur lines may not create as much cross traffic with the roadway as the main line, she and her family feel that the infrequent crossings make them even more unexpected and dangerous. They feel that the private spur lines should be required to meet or exceed the mainline standards in the area. Peuse further stated that there is a federal program called the Highway-Railroad Crossing Safety Program. According to the DOT website, this crossing safety program participates in the cost of safety improvements at public highway-railroad grade crossings, and the funds may be used for installing new crossing signal devices. Peuse asked that the Butler County Board of Supervisors pass a resolution to study whether, using Federal or State funding, the County could install traffic-control devices at the spur line. More than 100 citizens were present via zoom and many others called in support of Peuse's statement.

Mike Miner, Conservation Director, provided an update on Shell Rock River Watershed. A \$100,000 grant was awarded and a request for proposal will be the next step in order to obtain a management plan. The goal of the plan is to improve water quality, mitigate future flooding, and enhance recreational areas. Blau had a question about contaminants and flooding on his land. Miner directed him to the DNR regarding those questions. Board reviewed the existing County Farm Leases. Eddy motioned to terminate the two existing farm leases, second by Heidenwirth. All ayes. Motion carried. Board considered Resolution 1042 for inclusion in Iowa County Engineers Association's Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant application. County Engi-

neer, John Riherd, stated that a safety plan with a specific criterion is needed in order to be eligible for federal funds. Motioned by Heidenwirth to approve, second by Barnett. All ayes. Motion carried to adopt Resolution 1042 as follows: Butler County Resolution # 1042 RESOLUTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN SS4A GRANT APPLICATION
Moved by Heidenwirth and seconded by Barnett to approve the following resolution:
WHEREAS, as part of the new Federal Transportation Bill, Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), there is over \$1B of roadway safety funding available in the form of Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants. To be an eligible applicant for this new safety funding, a county MUST have an eligible Action Plan in place; and
WHEREAS, the Iowa County Engineers Association (ICEA) plans to apply for a SS4A grant to develop and supply all 99 counties in Iowa with an eligible Action Plan at no cost to the counties. ICEA encourages all 99 counties to participate in this grant application; and
WHEREAS, the Butler County Board of Supervisors will commit to achieve significant declines in roadway fatalities and serious injuries in Butler County; and
WHEREAS, the Butler County Board of Supervisors, after consulting with the Butler County Engineer, desires to participate in a joint SS4A grant to develop and receive an eligible Action Plan for Butler County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that this County does hereby request to be included in the statewide SS4A grant to develop Actions Plans for all 99 counties in Iowa

As the railroad crosses his driveway, he is sometimes unable to access the gravel road. He has missed appointments due to this. He also indicated that others have had taxes decreased because of the inconvenience, and he was wondering why his were not lowered. Kelly Peuse, the daughter of Joel and Rosemary Sult, was present to discuss the railroad crossing lighting in rural areas. Peuse provided a statement regarding the tragic death of her parents and introduced her family, who joined her in attendance. In her statement she indicated that she personally went to the crash site and saw that there is a main railroad line that runs east/west with a spur line running parallel just to the south of the main railroad line. At this intersection, the main line has cross buck signs with lights and audio alert. The spur line has crossbuck signs only, no lights and no audio alert. Neither line has crossing arms. Although the spur lines may not create as much cross traffic with the roadway as the main line, she and her family feel that the infrequent crossings make them even more unexpected and dangerous. They feel that the private spur lines should be required to meet or exceed the mainline standards in the area. Peuse further stated that there is a federal program called the Highway-Railroad Crossing Safety Program. According to the DOT website, this crossing safety program participates in the cost of safety improvements at public highway-railroad grade crossings, and the funds may be used for installing new crossing signal devices. Peuse asked that the Butler County Board of Supervisors pass a resolution to study whether, using Federal or State funding, the County could install traffic-control devices at the spur line. More than 100 citizens were present via zoom and many others called in support of Peuse's statement.

Mike Miner, Conservation Director, provided an update on Shell Rock River Watershed. A \$100,000 grant was awarded and a request for proposal will be the next step in order to obtain a management plan. The goal of the plan is to improve water quality, mitigate future flooding, and enhance recreational areas. Blau had a question about contaminants and flooding on his land. Miner directed him to the DNR regarding those questions.

Board reviewed the existing County Farm Leases. Eddy motioned to terminate the two existing farm leases, second by Heidenwirth. All ayes. Motion carried.
Board considered Resolution 1042 for inclusion in Iowa County Engineers Association's Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant application. County Engi-

neer, John Riherd, stated that a safety plan with a specific criterion is needed in order to be eligible for federal funds. Motioned by Heidenwirth to approve, second by Barnett. All ayes.
