OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS **CITY OF ALLISON** COUNCIL MINUTES OCTOBER 12, 2020 Regular Meeting:

Mayor Henrichs opened the regular meeting at 5:45 p.m. Council members present: Bangasser, Carlson, Davis, Henning, Heuer. Others Present: Randy Moad, Cory Miller, Mike Lammers - Deputy Sheriff, Kim Miller, Trent Stirling, Bill Tjaden - city insurance agent, Travis Fischer – Butler County Tribune-Journal, Don Moore – City Engineer. Motion by Henning with a second by Davis to approve the agenda. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Open Forum: No open forum items discussed.

Consent Agenda: Bangasser made a motion to approve the consent agenda with a second by Carlson with the exception of the building permits for Mike Kampman & Eric Scribner not being approved as they did not meet the set back requirements of the City Code. Those items approved were:

Approve Minutes from Meeting on Sept. 21, 2020

Approve Treasurer's Reports Approve Building Permit for Ran-dall Sluiter – 308 Hickory – Tear off existing steps and replace with a new deck

Approve Building Permit for Hugh and Deb Lore - 302 Fifth Street -Replace existing deck with an 8 X 14 deck

Approve Building Permit for Betty Rewerts - 616 Fourth Street - Re place sidewalk and driveway in alley

Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Items not approved:

Building Permit for Mike Kamp-man – 208 Fifth Street – 9 X 10 deck on the south side of home Building Permit for Eric Scribner 319 Fifth Street - Garden Shed

Council asked that these people be contacted to apply for a variance exception to the Code for these building permits. New Business:

Cory Miller was present at the meeting as a perspective buyer of the Farmers Feed & Grain, Council discussed the possibility of rebating some of the property taxes that would be paid on the Feed & Grain through the TIF Program as a way of helping the buyer. Our financial advisor will be contacted to draw up some scenarios of just how that could be done and this will be discussed further at a later meeting. Bill Tjaden presented Council with information from our workers comp carrier of coverage called non-statutory volunteer coverage. This would be for medical benefits only for volunteers of the park not to exceed \$25,000 and would

cost would be \$10/volunteer with a minimum annual premium of \$100. Motion by Henning with a second by Heuer to approve for the City to purchase this coverage for 10 volunteers. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Randy Moad had obtained an estimate from the DOT to blacktop 50' into the entrance from Hwy 3 into Wilder Park at a price of \$3,913. The DOT automatically does 6' and this would be 50' past that. This would be done in conjunction with the HWY 3 resurfacing project slated to begin in 2021. He said they have until Oct. 16, 2020, to respond to the DOT with their answer. Randy said they hoped this would help the potholes in that area. He said they could pay for it over a two-year period or a lump sum payment. Discussion ensued about semi's using this driveway to get to or from Allan, Inc. and would that blacktop hold up to the semi traffic. Don Moore city engineer - said what the DOT would normally use a 2" blacktop for this type of application and that would probably not hold up to the semi traffic. This item died due to lack of motion.

Council decided not to get a bid from the DOT for 50' from Hwy 3 on W. Lakeview Drive.

Don Moore – city engineer – reported to Council that the DNR did not accept his first anitdegradation report because back in 2018 there were some heavy flows out to the lagoon and now they expect him to design a system that would take 300,000 more gallons a day then originally designed thus he needed to go back out for pricing to meet designing a system for much larger flows. Several Council members expressed their concerns about the RAB System being such a new system and weren't sure if it was a truly proven system that would be a good fit for the City of Allison. Don said what he will do is get the numbers from the companies and then present them to Council before they would make any decisions on what system they will choose and to accept the revised Antidegradation report.

Motion by Bangasser with a second by Davis to sign the Subordination Agreement for 421 Spruce Street. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Council discussed municipal infractions with Deputy Sheriff - Mike Lammers. Council was concerned who would enforce infractions. Mike explained that if it is an infraction of a City Code occurs that would need to be enforced by our City Attorney. If someone violates a traffic code - then the sheriff's office would enforce that type of violation. Mike said he has been working with Glenda on many different types of code violations in the City and that has been working well. Many times, the Sheriff's office does notice different violations

and then informs Glenda to write them a letter on the code violation. The sheriff's office can then assist in making sure the code violation is corrected. If it does not get corrected - the City Attorney would need to be involved for doing a code violation infraction.

The discussion on our current web site and possible changes was ta-

bled to a later meeting. It was decided that the City does need to pursue an asbestos inspection of 409 Pine to get a true idea of what asbestos does exist at that location and get an estimate on what it would cost to abate the asbestos. Then we will go back out for bids on the demolition of the dwelling. The two contractors that submitted bids for the demolition will be contacted and inform them of this decision by City Council.

The bids for the duo compactor and the 7 X 9 steel garage door at 409 Pine were opened. The bids

were as follows: Mick Fishel Jr. bid \$400 for the duo compactor

Scot Henrichs bid \$50 for the garage door

Motion by Henning with a second by Carlson to accept the bids for the duo compactor from Mick Fishel Jr. for \$400 and the bid of \$50 for the garage door from Scot Henrichs. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Council told Glenda to write up a Resolution for the purchase of safety clothing for the public works department and they would approve it at the next meeting.

Motion by Bangasser with a second by Davis to approve Resolution #20-10.1 - Resolution requesting reimbursement from the lowa Covid 19 Government Relief Fund. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

The missing water bill bank deposit was discussed. It was reported that all but 16 of the 84 replacement checks have been received and that a second notice was being sent to those who have not responded yet. Also that all deposits will be done by walking them into the bank and not using the night deposit box.

Old Business:

Mowing at the cemetery was discussed as there have been several complaints on how the cemetery has looked this year. Stirling Lawn Care will be contacted to clean it up and to do a better job moving forward.
