CITY OF ALLISON REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2021

Regular Meeting:
Mayor Henrichs opened the regular meeting of the Allison City Council at 5:45 p.m. Council members present were Bangasser, Carlson, Davis, Henning, Heuer. Other present were: Coby Bangasser, Trent Stirling, John Endelman – Butler County REC, Don Moore – City Engineer, Larry Pump – Pump CPA Firm. Henning made a motion to approve the agenda with a second by Davis. Ayes: All. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Open Forum:
Don Moore was present at the meeting. He informed Council that he will have plans & specs for the lagoon project ready by the next meeting and that he would get the legal description of the needed electrical easement prepared.

The storm water issue at the REC warehouse was discussed at this point in the meeting as Trent had to leave the meeting early. Trent got prices on an arch pipe versus an elliptical pipe at a cost of \$825 per 6' section of 24" pipe with a 29" span and 18" rise and flared ends. John Endelman reported that it was the REC Boards thought was that all the homes from 7th Street along Locust Street to North Railroad Street should help pay for the repair of the pipe in their parking lot since this is storm water from that area. Council did not agree with that idea. Trent suggested that they just fix the pipe with 2 sections so it would be wide enough for one truck to drive over. John thought it should be at least 3 lengths of pipe. Council tabled the action until budget planning time. Trent stated that the pipes would not be available for delivery until next year sometime.
