The Fire Department is looking to use fundraiser money, township help, and some of their budget to make payments paying off the loan note. At this time, the City Clerk, Alexis Wiegmann is going to reach out to Northland Securities for loan information and to see what the interest rates are Public Works brought it to the Council's attention that there was a request for deaf child signs to be put up on Maple where one would be coming from the North and the other from the West. There was also a request to have Public Works go around town to look at signs and see what all needs to be replaced so that the city can start replacing
