### MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON MAY 23, 2023.

Meeting called to order at 9:01 A.M. by Chairman Greg Barnett with members Rusty Eddy and Wayne Dralle present. Moved by Dralle second by Eddy to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motioned by Dralle, second by Eddy to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried.

Adam Meyer, farmer in Ripley Township, spoke during Public Comment about a culvert being put in on other side of the road. Water is now pooling up in the ditch on his side of the road. John Riherd, Engineer, commented that the project is not complete, and they are planning on finishing it after harvest.

A date and time for a second Public Hearing to consider Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Ordinance for was set for May 30, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. Board recognized County Employee Years of Service Awards. The following employees were awarded for their respective years of service:

**Courthouse Maintenance** Bill Miller - 10 years Donis Dralle - 20 years County Assessor Karla Voss – 30 years County Attorney Wendy Dralle – 25 years County Auditor Lisa Beadle - 10 years County Planning & Zoning Misty Day - 10 years County Sheriff Curt Lubben – 20 years Lane Bass – 20 years Kiley Winterberg - 25 years Collin Freeseman – 25 years Kendall Siems – 20 years County Treasurer's Office Ashley White - 10 years Secondary Roads Jon Uhlenhopp – 45 years Daniel Christiansen – 25 years John Riherd - 15 years Nick Bell - 10 years Mike Eckhoff - 10 years Dan Christiansen was recognized on his retirement from Secondary

Road Department after 25 Years of Service.

Tom Stewart, Aplington, stated that he filed a criminal complaint in May of 2022 and he has concerns with the response time of the County Attorney and addressed them to the board. County Attorney, Dave Kuehner, outlined the complaint in question and provided his response and reasoning regarding it. Robert Rindels, Shell Rock, was not present to discuss the gravel road dump truck traffic.

Tammy Fleshner, EMS Association Chair, discussed the Butler County EMS plan. A full-time EMS coordinator will be hired after July 1, 2023, in order to assist existing local services. This individual will be at a minimum, EMT certified. Fleshner indicated that they are planning to start small and continue to take steps forward in eventually making EMS an essential service via an election. Flesher also shared they have been meeting with City Councils in May and will continue in June to explain the plan to the cities.

Dave Wangsness, Assessor re-

viewed the new 65+ Homestead Exemption recently passed in House File 718. Individuals that turned 65 years old before January 1, 2023, are now eligible. For the assessment year beginning on January 1, 2023, the exemption is for \$3,250 of taxable value. For assessment years beginning on or after January 1, 2024, the exemption is for \$6.500 of taxable value. Wangsness explained this new exemption is completely county-funded and the application deadline is July 1, 2023. Discussions were held regarding the effects this new exemption will have on FY24 budgets just recently adopted in March and April.

Board considered addendum to approve Dumont Telephone fiber project in Aplington, Parkersburg and Ackley area – adding 310<sup>th</sup> St near Parkersburg. Riherd discussed the project briefly. Moved by Eddy, second by Dralle to approve the addendum. All ayes. Motion carried. Board reviewed Resolution 1079-

2023 authorizing County Auditor to pay \$1,415,000 to the Iowa DOT Farm-to-Market fund from Capital Projects – matching funds for T47 resurfacing project. Riherd discussed the original funding split of the project between Federal, Farmto-Market and Capital Projects. He also explained that the final project costs were higher due to inflated costs which is why the request is for \$1.4 million versus the anticipated \$1 million from Capital Projects to pay back the Farm-to-Market account. Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to approve Resolution 1079-2023. Roll call was taken and Resolution 1079-2023 was adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION 1079-2023 Payment from Capital Projects WHEREAS, the Butler County Board of Supervisors does herby approve and authorize the County Auditor to pay \$1,415,000 from Capital Projects Fund 1500 to the Iowa DOT Farm-to-Market fund from Capital Projects – matching funds for T47 resurfacing project STBG-SWAP-C012(121)--FG-12. THEREFORE, a motion was made

by Eddy and seconded by Barnett stating such payment.

UPON Roll Call the vote thereon was as follows: AYES: Rusty Eddy Greg Barnett Wayne Dralle NAYS: None ABSENT: N/A WHEREUPON. The Resolution was declared duly adopted this 23<sup>r</sup> day of May, 2023 Greg Barnett, Chairperson ATTEST: Leslie Groen, County Auditor Motioned by Dralle, second by Eddy to approve claims. All ayes. Motion carried. Motioned by Dralle, second by Eddy to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:48 A.M. to May 30, 2023, at 9:00 A.M. All ayes. Motion carried.
