With limited public access to the courthouse due to COVID-19, this meeting was held telephonically with the public able to participate on a limited basis. This complies with Iowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or impractical".
Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with members Greg Barnett and Rusty Eddy present.
Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to approve both minutes from November 10, 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.

Director of Public Health Jennifer Becker reported 183 new cases since last Monday with 114 recovered, 3 hospitalizations and a 22.8% positivity rate. Total cases are at 784.
