If anyone has questions regarding their voting locations, please call the Auditor's Office.
Any voter who requires assistance to vote by reason of blind-

ness, disability, or inability to read or write may be given assistance at the polls by a person of the voter's choice, other than the voter's employer or agent of that employer, or officer or agent of the voter's union. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.
Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place

before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by 12 p.m. (Noon) Monday, November 8. Election Day Registrant testers must provide an approved form of identification. Absentee ballots are available to vote in person at the Butler County Auditor's Office during regular business hours through Monday, November 1. See Deadline information below. Curbside voting during the absentee voting period will also be available. Such voters are encouraged to call ahead to make arrangements to vote in their car.
In accordance with Chapter 52.35 of the Iowa Code, the public is also hereby notified that on Thursday, October 20th at 9:00 a.m. the Elections Department of the Butler County Auditor's Office will examine and test the vote tabulating machines to be used for this election. Such certification test is open to the public.

Shall the Board of Directors of the Nashua-Plainfield Community School District in the counties of Butler, Chickasaw, Floyd, and Bremer, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy and impose a voter-approved physical plant and equipment tax of not exceeding One Dollar and Thirty-Four Cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district, and be authorized annually, in combination, as determined by the board, to levy a physical plant and equipment property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, and to impose a physical plant and equipment income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the school district on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2022, and each year thereafter, (the percent of income surtax not to exceed twenty percent (20%) to be determined by the board each year) to be used for the purchase and improvement of grounds; the construction of schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; the purchase, lease, or lease-purchase of equipment or technology exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) in value per purchase, lease, or lease-purchase transaction or such other value as established by amending legislation; the payment of debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of library facilities; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; renting facilities under Iowa Code Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings or equipment; purchasing equipment authorized by law; or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law?

Leslie Groen has announced that absentee ballots for the November 2, 2021 City/School Elections are available in the Auditor's Office starting Wednesday, October 13th.
Butler County voters interested in voting absentee for the November 2nd City/School Election may file requests for absentee ballots with the Butler County Auditor's Office at that time.
Due to recent legislation, the time period to request absentee ballots has gone from 120 days to 70 days. The new legislation also has shortened the number of days that the Auditor's Office may have ballots available for absentee voting. Rather than 29 days, voters now have 20 days to vote absentee either by mail or in-person.
Voters wishing to receive an absentee ballot by mail for the City/School Election will need to complete an absentee ballot request form and return it to the Butler County Auditor's Office, PO BOX 325 Allison, IA 50602 before 5 p.m. October 18th. Additionally, completed ballots through the mail must be received by the Auditor's Office by 8 p.m. on Election Day.

2021 FINAL EQUALIZATION ORDERS ISSUED

Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 441.49, the Iowa Department of Revenue has notified the Butler County Auditor of final percentage adjustments to the 2021 valuations of real property in Butler County. Equalization occurs on an entire class of property, not on an individual property, and occurs on an assessing jurisdiction basis and not on a statewide basis. The adjustments are as follows:
The current equalization order for Butler County applies to the January 1, 2021, assessments for the following classes of property:
Decrease of 7% on Agricultural Land & Structures, Excluding Residential Dwellings on
Agricultural Realty, outside and within incorporated cities; and,

The Butler County Assessor requested and received Department of Revenue authorization to use an alternative method of applying the above listed 2021 equalization order to the following class of property:

Decrease Buildings 0%
on Agricultural Realty, outside and within incorporated cities
Decrease Land 7.36%
Assessed values are equalized by the Department of Revenue every two years. Local taxing authorities determine the final tax levies and may reduce property tax rates to compensate for any increase due to equalization. If there is an increase listed above, taxpayers may protest the final equalization order with their local board of review. Protests are accepted through October 31, 2021, at the County Assessor's Office.
