MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON

MARCH 2, 2021.

With social distancing guidelines being maintained at in-person meetings, an electronic participation option is made available. This complies with Iowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or impractical". Meeting called to order at 9:00

A.M. by Chairman Greg Barnett with members Rusty Eddy and Tom Heidenwirth present. Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion Minutes of the previous meeting

were read. Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried. No public comment received.

Public Health Director, Jennifer Becker, shared there were 11 new cases, 1 recovery, one hospitalization and no deaths this week. Becker stated as of today we had a 3% positivity rate. Becker shared they were able to have all of last week's clinics as planned and beginning today, they will be vaccinating every day. Becker shared they are doing 450 boost shots and Friday they are doing another first dose clinic Becker explained they are administering 150 of the first dose vaccine and getting the rest out to doctors in the county to administer to their own patients. It has helped get more people vaccinated quickly as many on the list have stated they already received their vaccine at their doc tor's office. Becker confirmed the Johnson and Johnson vaccine was approved over the weekend, is being allotted in lowa, but is going to counties with larger meat packers and manufacturers. Becker explained she is gathering numbers for the state regarding the manufacturers in the county and they are hoping to get the Johnson & Johnson one-time shot for those manufacturers. Becker explained we are still in 1B - Tier 1 priority group, and it looks like we will be moving to Tier 2 very soon but they have not received that guidance yet. Becker also requested that if people are on several lists and they get the shot, if they could please contact the other lists and notify them to be removed from their lists. Sara Trepp confirmed she has added the forms required at the appointment and Trepp will clarify the forms are required for the Primary and Booster shot.

Barnett shared the details of the Tentative Agreement between the **Butler County Board of Supervisors** and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 234 which spells out a 2.5% wage increase over the next two fiscal years. Engineer John Riherd explained additional details regarding a deletion of the dedicated safety information that will be addressed in the handbook. Riherd also explained an added separation with mechanic and foreman wage rate increases created for increased leadership participation. Riherd explained they will also have the discretion to es tablish wage differentials for special education or certifications. Moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to approve the Tentative Agreement between the Board of Supervisors and the union. All ayes. Motion car-

Barnett reviewed the FY22 funding requests. Discussions were held regarding the Historical Society being active or not, Leslie Groen mentioned we have not heard from them for FY22 funding and it was decided they must not be active at this time. Additional discussions were held regarding the Butler County Fair Board because they did not have a 2020 Fair. Barnett shared the fair did not have income but they still had the 4H fair and what the county gave in funding was a wash to complete the 2020 4H portion of the fair. Kasi Koehler and Bill Tjaden were present at the meeting to go over the insurance renewal for the renewal period beginning on 4/4/2021. Kasi explained that ICAP paid an appraisal company to appraise our City Buildings over \$200,000 in replacement value. The total value on all City buildings went from \$3,784,842 in 2020 to \$8,586,104 for 2021 after this appraisal was done. This, of course, did increase the premium

somewhat and the water tower and swimming pools were also added to the policy as previous Councils choose not to cover those items. Kasi did explain if the City choose not to insure the water tower and pool that the City could save approximately \$3,000 off the renewal premium as presented. She said they could also choose to insure the buildings for lesser values but then they would be covered under an actual value basis and not on replacement cost and then there would not be a blanket coverage on the buildings. She did not recommend the reduced coverage option. Council is seeking another bid and that will be presented at the meeting on March 22, 2021 so they will be making a decision after that

Lee presented Council with preliminary plans he had drawn up to go out for bids on the West 4 blocks of 8th Street and Linden Street from 7th to 8th Street, 3 blocks of 3rd Street from Birch Street to Locust Street and filling cracks on the Farm to Market Route from Hwy 3 to Linden Street. He used the same specs as used on the Cherry Street project with 4" of asphalt, an 8" granular base with a geogrid option. The Council choose to use a completion date of October 1, 2021 for the project and for bids to be due and read at City Hall on April 12, 2021 at 1:00 P.M. with a final approval by Council at their meeting that evening of April 12, 2021 at 5:45 P.M. This complies with Iowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or Meeting called to order at 9:00

A.M. by Chairman Greg Barnett with members Rusty Eddy and Tom Heidenwirth present. Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Minutes of the previous meeting

were read. Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried. No public comment received.

Public Health Director, Jennifer Becker, shared there were 11 new cases, 1 recovery, one hospitalization and no deaths this week. Becker stated as of today we had a 3% positivity rate. Becker shared they were able to have all of last week's clinics as planned and beginning today, they will be vaccinating every day. Becker shared they are doing 450 boost shots and Friday they are doing another first dose clinic Becker explained they are administering 150 of the first dose vaccine and getting the rest out to doctors in the county to administer to their own patients. It has helped get more people vaccinated quickly as many on the list have stated they already received their vaccine at their doctor's office. Becker confirmed the Johnson and Johnson vaccine was approved over the weekend, is being allotted in Iowa, but is going to counties with larger meat packers and manufacturers. Becker explained she is gathering numbers for the state regarding the manufacturers in the county and they are hoping to get the Johnson & Johnson one-time shot for those manufacturers. Becker explained we are still in 1B - Tier 1 priority group, and it looks like we will be moving to Tier 2 very soon but they have not received that guidance yet. Becker also request-

ed that if people are on several lists and they get the shot, if they could please contact the other lists and notify them to be removed from their lists. Sara Trepp confirmed she has added the forms required at the appointment and Trepp will clarify the forms are required for the Primary and Booster shot.

Barnett shared the details of the Tentative Agreement between the **Butler County Board of Supervisors** and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 234 which spells out a 2.5% wage increase over the next two fiscal years. Engineer John Riherd explained additional details regarding a deletion of the dedicated safety information that will be addressed in the handbook. Riherd also explained an added separation with mechanic and foreman wage rate increases created for increased leadership participation. Riherd explained they will also have the discretion to establish wage differentials for special education or certifications.
