Planning and Zoning Administrator, Misty Day, reviewed the preliminary plat and plot proposal and mentioned there were a few typographical errors were noted and will be corrected prior to submitting

the final plat. Day provided CSR information and the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation. Day shared a neighbor's objection to the subdivision regarding the intention of the sale, mentioned they have approached Iowa Association of Realtors, but stated that is a private situation between buver and seller. Additional concerns from the neighbors regarding their organic farming practices including the smell, flies, compost pile and livestock were also shared.
